- Academics/School Day: We are returning to full in person instruction with pre-COVID school attendance
 days and times. Unless quarantined or sick, students should be at school for in-person instruction, as
 mandated by the Illinois State Board of Education.
- Masks: Are required to be worn by students, staff and all visitors inside of our buildings.
- Stay home when you are sick: Staff and students are asked to stay home when sick with any illness. Our Health Plan on our website has more information
- Physical Distancing: Per CDC/IDPH guidelines, we will physically distance to the best of our ability. The
 Illinois State Board of Education makes it clear that we cannot exclude students from school in order to
 achieve physical distancing.
- Quarantines: The District will provide learning opportunities for those who are quarantined and unvaccinated. The District will follow quarantine guidelines from CUPHD. You may contact CUPHD at any time with questions. (See full Opening Plan #5, bullet point #4)
- Transportation: Masks are required on buses. Transportation schedules will be released prior to school. There are no capacity restrictions on our buses.
- Breakfast and Lunch: The District will return to our normal meal options, locations, etc.
- Handwashing/Hygiene: We will teach (where appropriate) and promote/encourage hand washing/hygiene to prevent the spread of germs. Hand sanitizer will be readily available.
- COVID 19 Testing: Regular testing is strongly recommended for all students and staff especially those with any symptoms of COVID 19, and will continue to be provided by the District.
- Cleaning: Custodial staff will provide appropriate daily cleaning to support a clean and safe environment. The District has EPA approved air-filters and cleaning solutions.

This plan is subject to change at any time during the school year based on local school, community and/or data from health agencies.
