We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for <SCHOOL NAME>. For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2021-22. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

We continue to identify gaps in student achievement between socio-economic groups and concentrating our efforts to meet the needs of all students. Some of the programs that we have implemented included, but are not limited to:

- SEL Mentoring
- Student Tutoring Program
- AE (academic enrichment) classes for students missing a few of key concepts in core courses
- CORE (Support/extension/remediation) for all students.
- MTSS- strategies, research and implementation
- Implementation of PLC's (professional learning communities) to focus on student data, instruction and curriculum needs.
