## SUPPLY LIST FOR SCIENCE CLASSES WITH MR. IDDINGS

NOTE: Book Bag MUST be kept in locker during class - NOT ALLOWED IN CLASS

- If your student feels a need to drink in class, they need a clear bottle, and can only have water in it. Due to having organisms and chemicals around, no eating is allowed in any of the science rooms.
- One 2-inch binder with 8 Tab dividers to hold all science material given throughout the year. This will serve as a study aid. All classes will need them for organization and for study aids..
- 1 Pack of loose leaf paper ( 100 sheets) 1 pack at start of year, but may need to be replenished.
- 1 Pack of \#2 pencils (Must bring daily)

NOTE: I recommend mechanical pencils so they do not need sharpened during class.

- Extra Eraser (Must bring daily)
- Pens: One Black OR Blue AND One of Some Other Color, but not Purple (Must have daily)
- 1 Pack of highlighters (Must have 1 daily)
- 6 Glue sticks (Must have daily) - I recommend three to start, but may need more.
- 1 Pencil pouch (Recommended to carry the smaller items)
- 1 pack Index cards. $3 " \times 5 "$ (1 pack at start of year, but may need to be replenished)
- 1 Pack of graph paper (at least 50 sheets)
(1 pack at start of year. The graphs will be cut and pasted into lab reports)
- 1 Box of Kleenex (To be used in the classroom)
