Dear Parents/Guardians and Students,

We hope that all of you are enjoying your summer break. With the start of school approaching, we would like to give you some information. The first day of school is August 13th. School is returning to five days a week which will include bus transportation. Our minimum days will be on Monday. All internet services provided by the district will be shut off. If you have any questions or concerns please contact the district office. As of right now, masks are recommended indoors, if things change we will notify you. If you have any concerns please let us know. Physical distancing in schools will no longer be recommended “due to the obstacles it would present to California schools to fully reopen”. No mask will be required outdoors. In the coming weeks, we will be sending out the emergency/acknowledgment page and household income forms. This needs to be signed and turned in before school starts. We are accepting kindergarten students' enrollment packets now. You can pick them up and turn them in at the district office. Students must have their shots up to date before they can start. In addition, 7th grade students need their shots updated and registration forms completed and submitted (tdap) as soon as possible. Included in this email is the district calendar and the high school bell schedule. If you have any questions, you can contact the district office. After August 1st, you can contact the high school and elementary offices.

Currently over 98% of students will return in-person to their school; however, alternative educational options may be available for students who may have medical situations or other needs. Depending on a student's individual situation, these options may include: Site/District Independent Studies Program, To enroll in a Site/District Independent Studies Program, a student should have demonstrated academic success in last school year's distance learning experience and a parent/guardian must contact the Principal to arrange a conference between a parent/guardian, student, administrator and/or certificated staff member. If it is determined that a Site/District Independent Studies Program is the best option for a student, a master agreement between school personnel, parent/guardian and student will be reviewed and signed to acknowledge the expectations for the student during the 2021-22 school year. The same meeting process will be utilized to disenroll a student from the Site/District Independent Studies Program. Please check your emails frequently because we will be sending updates out. We appreciate your patience and we look forward to this upcoming school year.
