## Monett Middle School/Monett High School Virtual Instruction Program Student Contract

Updated 8/1/2022

Welcome to the Monett Virtual Instruction Program. This program serves to provide traditional virtual, credit recovery, or credit acquisition courses for all interested Monett High School students. This program is a privilege afforded to students choosing to take an online course as part of their course load in order to meet graduation requirements. The information below is vital for student success in the Monett Virtual Instruction Program.

- Change in the enrollment status must be by August 7 for fall semester and December 7 for spring semester. New students enrolling after the beginning of the school year are not eligible to request virtual instruction until the end of the semester.
- The student and the parent/guardian will sign this student contract, stating that the student and parent/guardian agree with the terms and conditions associated with the Monett Virtual Instruction Program.
- The student will receive a school issued Chromebook. The insurance fee must be paid. This will assist the technology department resolve any issues that may occur.
- Each course the student is enrolled in will have assignments, projects, and assessments that the student
  will be responsible to complete on-time and at an appropriate level. Failure to make adequate progress may
  result in a change in enrollment status.
- The student must actively participate or the student will be removed from the virtual courses and may not be able to enroll in future virtual courses.
  - (MHS/MMS) Failing 2 or more courses will make students ineligible for virtual learning the following semester.
- (MHS) If at any point the student becomes deficient in graduation requirements according to Monett guidelines, the student will be removed from virtual classes and placed in seated classes within the building.
- (MHS) The student is required to take state-required EOC examinations administered by a district employee if an EOC is required for the course. Counselors will schedule EOC exams with the student.
- (MMS) The student is required to take the district-level benchmark assessments and the MAP examination administered by a district employee. Counselor will schedule the MAP exams with the student.
- Students enrolled in Virtual Instruction will be ineligible to participate in extracurricular and co-curricular activities. Students will not be able to participate in any school sponsored activities or field trips.

I (student) understand that successful completion of this program depends on my level of effort, quality of work and adherence to the policies, procedures and personal responsibilities associated with the Monett Virtual Instructional Program.
