West Hempstead Library Card Registration

- Families must register, **in person**, at the West Hempstead Library in order for your child/children to be eligible for our summer reading program.
- No appointment is necessary
- Adults must bring one photo identification card and 2 official letter.
 - (Ex: phone bill, utility bill, bank statement, mortgage, lease, etc.)
- Children can register for their own card with parental proof of residency
