

Medication

If your child requires prescription medication during the school day, the following things are required by the New Hampshire Department of Education:

1. form from physician
2. form from the parent/guardian

The medication must:

1. be in the original pharmacy labeled container
2. be no more than a 30 day supply
3. be delivered to the school by an adult

Asthma inhalers and Epinephrine auto injectors require an Asthma Action Plan or Anaphylaxis Action Plan from the prescribing physician each school year. These medications may be carried by a student (when age/ability appropriate) and self administered with written permission from the parent/guardian and the prescriber.

Over the counter Medications:

The health office stocks some common over the counter medications such as Acetaminophen (Tylenol) and Ibuprofen (Advil). Written permission from the parent/guardian is required each school year. Here is the form.

If your child requires over the counter medication that we do not have, please bring it in with a written request for it to be administered and we are happy to help with that.
