Re: State Report Card

Greetings Lennox School District Families,

I am writing to call your attention to our District's performance as measured by the South Dakota Report Card. I want to recognize our staff's dedication to continuous improvement as can be observed through a historical analysis of our SPI (school performance index). Below, I provided a table that shows each school's progress in this metric dating back to 2015-2016. Please note that due to the pandemic years of COVID-19 (2019-2020 and 2020-2021), the South Dakota Department of Education did not issue a SPI score for schools. SPI scores were provided to each school district for 2021-2022, but were not reported publicly on the State Report Card. I included a snapshot of what information is used to calculate the SPI score and a link to the full calculation guide. Lastly, you will find an image that reflects the district proficiency scores in comparison to the State, in English language arts and math. I encourage you to take some time to review this information and explore the State Report Card (links provided at the end of this document).



Student Performance: Students take the annual state assessments for English language arts and mathematics in grades 3-8 and 11, and science in grades 5, 8, and 11. These tests measure the concepts and skills taught in the classroom and whether students met the state's grade-level expectations in each subject. The graphs below show the percentage of full-academic year students who met or exceeded the expectations on the state assessment in each subject. Please note that science scores will not be available from the State until January.
