### Reports

1. Superintendent's Report
  - a) End of Year Report – Superintendent Fry shared a roller coaster graphic to describe and report on all the accomplishments that the College Place public schools are celebrating after an unprecedented year. Not only did College Place Schools survive but thrived. The students, teachers and district worked hard accomplished so much.
  - b) Classified ESE of CP Collective Bargaining Agreement – Superintendent Fry reported the ESE of CP the successful bargaining of a full open contract and has reached a tentative agreement with salary comparable growth; job classifications and updates, and shoring up some evaluation language. Mr. Fry also updated the board on the Tentative Agreement on the partial open contract with WWVEA and the ongoing collaboration with the coach's association.
  - c) Class of 2022 Parking Lot Painting – Superintendent Fry led the conversation with an explanation of the tradition of high school students painting their parking spots. Mauve Thompson, Eli Duran, and Davis Fry presented their proposal and asked permission of the Board to continue the project. They laid out and defined a clear process, firm guidelines and expectations of the proposal.
2. Recommendation for Adoption of “Flash Curriculum” for Grades 6-12 Comprehensive Sexual Health. The curriculum team presented their recommendations of adopting the Flash curriculum to the Board. They shared lessons, and answered the Board's questions of parents opting out and age appropriate teaching. Superintendent Fry spoke on behalf of Board member Todd Stubblefield in his absence. He spoke of his concerns of the overreach from the state regarding this curriculum and questions the reason for districts having to submit the curriculum to the state when they do not request the submission of curriculum for any other subject taught.
3. Recommendation for Adoption of “Character Strong Servant Leadership Curriculum” for Grades 9-12 CPHS Leadership - The curriculum team presented their recommendation of adopting the Character Strong curriculum to the Board, shared a lesson, and answered the Board's questions. Sarah Thompson piloted the curriculum this past year.
