

INYO PROMISE

The Inyo County educational community, in cooperation with Cerro Coso Community College and the University of Nevada, Reno, does promise that the graduates of an Inyo county high school have two guaranteed options for higher education:

1. Cerro Coso Community College / Bishop

- a. Any student with a 2.0 GPA upon graduation will be guaranteed admission to Cerro Coso Community college/Bishop and provided through the Eastern Sierra Foundation, a full tuition and a \$300 per semester book credit for up to two years in order to complete an Associates of Arts (AA) degree or a professional certificate program. Students must complete 12 units per semester and maintain a 2.0 GPA to keep the scholarship.
- b. Students who complete at least 24 transferable credits or an Associate of Arts degree from Cerro Coso with a 3.0 GPA will be admitted to the University of Nevada, Reno and tuition reduced by \$11,00 per year – (also known as Western Undergraduate Exchange: WUE).

2. University of Nevada, Reno (UNR)

- a. The Inyo County Board of Education will grant a \$1,000 scholarship to all Inyo County high school students who attend UNR as a freshman.
- b. **Western Undergraduate Exchange WUE:** Any BUHS graduate who completes the following courses: 4 years of English, 3 years of Science (2 years lab), 3 years of Mathematics and 3 years of Social Science with a 3.25 cumulative GPA in those subjects AND a SAT score of at least 1240 (Critical Reading + Math) OR ACT Composite score of at least 26 will be accepted to UNR and tuition reduced by \$11,000 per year. Students must apply by February 1st.
- c. **Nevada Advantage:** Any BUHS graduate who completes the following courses: 4 years of English, 3 years of Science (2 years lab), 3 years of Mathematics and 3 years of Social Science with a 3.0 cumulative GPA in those subjects AND a SAT score of at least 1100 (Critical Reading + Math) OR ACT Composite score of at least 22 will be accepted to UNR and tuition reduced by about \$8,000 per year. Students must apply by February 1st.
