Stanton MS & Elementary Grading Policy During COVID-19

In order for Stanton MS & Elem to calculate grades for student promotion and grade level credit with emergency school closures due to COVID-19:

- Grades in the gradebook will be frozen as of March 6th (which will be the last day of the 4th 6th weeks)
- Beginning March 16th we will shift to the new grading system: I (Incomplete), F
 (Fail) or P (Pass)

• Paper packets will be available for pickup for grades K-8 every 2 weeks.

Additionally, students receiving special education services will have progress in their IEP goals and tracked in eSPED. In an effort to be fair and consistent, all distance learning, grades will be formative and identified as Incomplete, PASS or FAIL. Teacher contact logs will be used for on-going progress monitoring. Teachers will review student work and support instruction by delivering a distance learning system that accounts for periodic check-ins and feedback. Each core subject area teacher will provide students and parents with the option of recorded lessons via zoom/google classroom/teacher letter. For students who do not have the internet, teachers will be reaching out during "office hours" to monitor progress. Several of the teachers have created access accounts that allow students to send messages and work.

EXPECTATIONS

Grading and Attendance

To receive credit and attendance for the courses for this school year students are expected to complete the assignments. Students who do not complete work will have an "I" for INCOMPLETE in the gradebook; this is the equivalent of a "0" (zero), if the student does not complete work in the allotted time given for make-up.
