Dear Wayland-Cohocton School Community,

Our district conducted lead water testing by Stohl Environmental on Feb. 19, 2020, at the Wayland and Cohocton School campuses and we have received the laboratory analysis results for the *potable water sampling. One hundred fifty (150) potable samples were collected at the Wayland campus and thirty-one (31) potable samples were collected at the Cohocton Campus. At each of the locations noted above, samples were collected to evaluate the water quality from the fixture, from the service line into the school and from the main water line outside of the school.

Samples were collected in accordance with the USEPA's guidance document form investigating lead in drinking water at schools. I am writing to make you aware that the district had twenty-six (26) samples at the Wayland campus and two (2) samples at the Cohocton campus that contained a lead concentration equal to or exceeding the guidance level of 15 ppb for lead in school drinking water.

As a result, the district established a remediation plan regarding the twenty-eight (28) sources. All of the identified sources twenty-eight (28) were replaced with new fixtures. Upon the new installation and repair of the fixtures, the district conducted a new first draw sample by John Polito and EMSL Analytical Inc. All fixtures now comply with NYS Lead in Drinking Water guidelines. On the next page are several informational resources regarding lead in water:
