

Transportation Services for Middle and High School GESD Scholars 2023-24

City of Gloversville hourly bus schedule has a stop at **Lincoln St./West St. at 6:55 a.m., 7:55 a.m., 8:55 a.m, 9:55 a.m.** GESD scholars are able to use all city buses free of charge.

Afternoon stops for this run are in the same location (Lincoln/West St). The city bus will arrive at **Lincoln St./West St. at 2:55 p.m., 3:55 p.m., 4:55 p.m.** with scheduled drop off points throughout the city.

A special Gloversville city bus run will also serve our middle/high school scholars on the east side of the city with stops at four locations along Kingsboro Avenue.. Locations/times for city morning bus stops serving the middle/high school campus are as follows:

- **Kingsboro Ave. and State St. (Veterans' Park) – 7:00 a.m.**
- **Kingsboro Ave. and 8th Ave– 7:03 a.m.**
- **Kingsboro Ave. and Melchoir Park – 7:07 a.m.**
- **Kingsboro Ave. and East Fulton St. – 7:10 a.m.**
- **GHS and GMS campus drop off – 7:20 a.m.**

At 2:35 p.m, a city bus will stop at Wohlfarth's Pond on McNab Ave. to pick up middle/high school scholars. Drop offs will be at the following locations and times:

- **Kingsboro Ave. and East Fulton St. – 2:45 p.m.**
- **Kingsboro Ave. and Melchoir Park – 2:48 p.m.**
- **Kingsboro Ave. and 8th Ave – 2:52 p.m.**
- **Kingsboro Ave. and State St. (Veterans' Park) – 2:55 p.m.**

GESD is also providing middle/high school Main Street morning bus service: GESD will run a school bus each morning school is in session to pick up Middle/HS scholars at the following locations. ***(Please Note, There will NOT be an afternoon bus for this run)***

- **N. Main St. and Wooster St. – 6:55 a.m.**
- **N. Main St. and 8th Ave. – 7:00 a.m.**
- **N. Main St. and Grand St. – 7:04 a.m.**
- **S. Main St. and Pine St. – 7:10 a.m.**
- **S. Main St. and Lexington Ave. – 7:13 a.m.**
- **GHS and GMS campus drop off – 7:22 a.m.**

Please note: All transportation services described above are not required by law, nor subject to New York State transportation aid. These free transportation services are an "in-kind service" offered by the board of education to GESD scholars to help foster daily attendance in school. Ridership on these buses is a privilege and not a right. Failure to abide by city, district and HFM BOCES policies, rules, expectations, and procedures will be subject to discipline in accordance with the GESD code of conduct and may result in loss of ridership privileges.
