

State of Illinois Health Requirements for the 2021-2022 School Year

Requirements by Grade Level

Preschool Students:

- Physical exam—Parents, please complete the yes/no questions on the back and sign and date
- Complete immunization record signed by a doctor
 - (4) Tdap
 - (3) Polio
 - (4) Hib
 - (3) Hep B
 - (1) MMR
 - (1) Varicella
 - (4) Pneumococcal
- Birth certificate—legal birth certificate required (not hospital footprint copy)

Kindergarten Students:

- Physical exam—Parents, please complete the yes/no questions on the back and sign and date
- Complete immunization record signed by a doctor
 - (5) Tdap
 - (4) Polio
 - (4) Hib
 - (3) Hep B
 - (2) MMR
 - (2) Varicella
 - (4) Pneumococcal
- Birth certificate—legal birth certificate required (not hospital footprint copy)
- Dental exam on IL form due May 15, 2022 (dated within 18 months of May 15th deadline)
- Eye exam on IL form dated within one year of the first day of school

Second Grade Students:

- Dental exam on IL form due May 15, 2022 (dated within 18 months of May 15th deadline)

Sixth Grade Students:

- Physical exam—Parents, please complete the yes/no questions on the back and sign and date
 - Sports physical NOT acceptable—Certificate of Child Health Exam form required
- Complete immunization record signed by a doctor
 - Tdap
 - Meningitis
- Dental exam on IL form due May 15, 2022 (dated within 18 months of May 15th deadline)

Ninth Grade Students:

- Physical exam—Parents, please complete the yes/no questions on the back and sign and date
 - Sports physical NOT acceptable—Certificate of Child Health Exam form required
- Complete immunization record signed by a doctor
- Dental exam on IL form due May 15, 2022 (dated within 18 months of May 15th deadline)

Twelfth Grade Students:

- Proof of receiving (2) Meningitis vaccinations
 - First dose on or after the 11th birthday, second dose received at least 8 weeks after the first
 - Only one dose is required if the first dose was received at 16 years of age or older

PLEASE HAVE ALL DOCUMENTATION TURNED IN BY THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

For the 2021-2022 school year, any child entering the 12th grade shall show proof of having received two doses of meningococcal conjugate vaccine prior to entering the 12th grade. The first dose shall have been received on or after the 11th birthday, and the second dose shall have been received on or after the 16th birthday, at least eight weeks after the first dose. If the first dose is administered when the child is 16th years of age or older, only one dose is required. Please speak with your child's healthcare provider over the summer regarding your child's vaccination needs. Herrin Unit 4 Schools must have documentation or when the vaccine was administered in order for your child to be in compliance with requirements set by the State of Illinois.
