## UNDERSTANDING DATA ACCESS AND USE: PRESCHOOL THROUGH AGE 20 IN WASHINGTON

## "P20W" DATA EQUITY ROUNDTABLES

- Washington state is one of the most data rich states when it comes to P20W (preschool to Grade 20, workforce) data and data security and governance. However, the data is often inaccessible to practitioners, educators, researchers. policymakers, and community leaders and advocates. This leads to a lack of public trust of the system because there is no way to see tangible changes rooted in useful/relevant data even though so much data is collected and stored.
- In partnership with the Education Research and Data Center (ERDC) and Washington STEM, we are launching a P20W Data Systems Study to see if there are opportunities to improve the technical tools and processes used to collect. organize, store, and prepare P20W data for analysis.
- Information collected during these Roundtable Sessions will be combined with input from all regional networks and shared with the ERDC and other state/ regional agencies such as DCYF, OSPI, etc. and legislators.
- These sessions are intended for organizations involved in early learning, K-12 education, postsecondary education, career pathways and workforce development across preschool through age 20, and open to all.
