THE DISTRICT

Welcome to The White Salmon Valley School District, a district of approximately 1085 students serving the cities of White Salmon and Bingen, and the outlying areas of Husum, Underwood and Snowden. We have four schools serving grades K-12 and an alternative school that serves students throughout the area. The district has a diverse population of students that is approximately 32% Hispanic.

Teachers in WSVSD take great pride in their work and continually seek to improve their knowledge and instructional skills. Nearly 20% of teachers in the district hold National Board Certification. The district also employs a large number of support staff. The district benefits from many of the programs offered by ESD112, which serves districts in Southwest Washington. It is also involved in many state and federal grants including Title I, Title II, Learning Assistance, Career and Technical Education, Beginning Teacher Assistance, Bilingual, Math and Science, after school programs, and Gifted programs.

The community has a history of strong support for schools, regularly approving maintenance and operation levies including a new Capital Projects Levy. The community is also involved in many ways through classroom and school-based events. Additionally, in its 15 years of existence, the White Salmon Valley Education Foundation has contributed an amazing amount of funding to enhance programs for our students. Also, our PTO contributes about \$45K annually to our K-8 programs.

COMPENSATION

The Board will negotiate a multi-year contract with a competitive salary with a salary range of \$160,000 - \$180,000 plus benefits depending on experience.
