Responsibilities

- Assists in the development and implementation of tiered behavior supports, plans, and intervention programs that address the needs of at-risk students
- Receives referrals and confers with students, parents, teachers, community agencies, and law enforcement
- Generates and accounts for data collection systems to monitor student behaviors, the effectiveness of interventions, and makes modifications as needed
- Thoroughly documents student behavior, reports to parents, and communicates with staff
- Responds to student or parent concerns and collaborates with staff to gain resolution
- Supervises students on campus before and after school; monitors students during lunch, recess, passing periods, and other activities; instructs students in an appropriate behavior; disciplines students in accordance with established guidelines
- Provides direction to a variety of faculty, staff, and student programs and services; participates in informal classroom visitations and observations regarding behavior and student success in the classroom and provides recommendations and suggestions for support, as appropriate

- Ability to withstand the physical and mental rigors of being a behavior interventionist.
