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Back-to-School Conferences - August 17th, 12:00-8:00

Our orientation conferences will follow a similar format to last year. Your learner's advisory teacher will send an email on Wednesday that will include a link to sign-up for a 15-minute time slot to meet their teacher. You will be able to get their schedule and locker information, take school pictures, sign up for bus transportation, and take care of paperwork and the Device Usage Fee with Damage Protection.

We ask that only the student and parents attend their conference to limit crowding. Please refer to the included building map to identify teacher locations.

Conference Day TO-DO List

To make the most of your conference experience, **everyone** will need to complete the following items before you leave:

- **Welcome Packet** - Insurance forms, class dues, donation requests, t-shirt order forms, Best Buddies, and a variety of informational sheets (receive during learner's advisory conference)
- **iPad Agreement & Fee** - Two things will need to be completed before your son/daughter receives their iPad. *Beat the rush on conference night by completing these things online today!* (located in the Commons)

 - **Online > www.schoolphotosbymark.com > click “order here” > choose the “click here to order” > enter “HASD” for the event name, click “search” > click on Harrisburg School District > North Middle School > enter your email address and click “login” > choose photo packages > when finished, click on “shopping cart” icon and enter your students’ information as well as your own.**
 - **Picture Retakes:** Tuesday, October 5th
- **Advisory Conference:** During your reserved time, have a brief conference with your learner’s advisory teacher. Here you will learn more about the teacher team and receive schedules, welcome packets, and locker information. *You can expect to receive an email from the teacher with a link to sign up for times early next week. ([This map lists where you can find each teacher](#)).*
- **Locker Check:** Swing by your learner’s locker and have them practice their combination. *This year, we are asking everyone to refrain from decorating lockers or placing unnecessary shelves/baskets. **Backpacks will be allowed this year to reduce locker visits.*** Learners will be asked to visit their lockers only three times per day (in the morning, before and after gym to get appropriate shoes, and at the end of the day).
- **School Supplies:** [Click on this link and select your learner’s list.](#) *Please drop off Clorox Wipes and Kleenex with your advisory teacher. While you are at your locker, drop off any other extra supplies.*
- **Cell phones:** Remind your learner that cell phones are not allowed in the classroom throughout the day. They should be silenced and placed in the locker as soon as they arrive at school and remain there until the end of the day.

- **Bus Transportation:** Meet the drivers, sign up, and get Information about your learner's bus route. (located in the gym) Roger.Timmerman@k12.sd.us
- **School Lunches:** Information about how to pay for lunches and access Free/Reduced Application online. (located in the Commons)
- **Student Council:** Stop by our student council table to order a class t-shirt!

From the Athletic Department:

For Parents and Athletes entering Grades 7-12 as well as those entering Grade 6 who plan to participate in Cross Country or Wrestling:

The **South Dakota High School Activities Association (SDHSAA)** and the **Harrisburg School District** require certification as to the adequacy of a student's health for athletic participation.

- This certification shall be restricted to a duly licensed Doctor of Medicine, Doctor of Osteopathy, Doctor of Chiropractic, licensed physician's assistant, or licensed nurse practitioner.
- All exams must be signed by authorized medical personnel as listed above.
- Stamping the name of a medical clinic or a medical association as a substitute for the Doctor's signature is unacceptable.
- **Physicals taken in the spring for the ensuing school term shall be taken after April 1.**
 - For example, a physical taken on or after April 1, 2021, is valid for the 2020-22 school year.
 - A physical taken on March 1, 2021, expires on July 1, 2021, and is **NOT** valid for the 2021-22 school year.

To meet the requirements of the SDHSAA and the District, please follow the steps below. **Once all steps are complete you are cleared to participate. Again, this process MUST be completed, and forms MUST be submitted to the HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES OFFICE prior to the first day of your sport's season.**

Please complete these steps prior to the first day of practice to be cleared to participate in your activity!

Step 1: Athletes fill out the [Pre-participation Physical Evaluation HISTORY FORM](#). Take the **HISTORY FORM** and the **SDHSAA PHYSICAL EXAMINATION FORM** to an authorized medical provider (listed above) for a physical exam.

Step 2: Athletes and Parents fill out the [Parental and Student Medical Consent and Concussion Awareness Forms](#) required by the SDHSAA and the District.

Step 3: Once you have you have completed **Steps 1 & 2**, you may submit the forms in one of two ways:

- Turn in ALL forms to the Harrisburg High School Office. **(DO NOT turn forms into any Middle School or Elementary School Office!)**
- E-mail an electronic copy of ALL forms to Cassidy Ayotte (cassidy.ayotte@k12.sd.us).

INCOMPLETE MATERIAL WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED, PLEASE MAKE SURE THE ENTIRE PACKET IS COMPLETE.
