Qualify vs. Served

- Districts qualify for Title I funding based on the number of low income students residing within the district.
- Students who <u>receive services</u> are those who show an academic need.
- Schools have an Annual Title I meeting.
- Schools must allocate a percentage of their Title I money for parental involvement.
- Districts must allocate 1% of money to parental involvement.
