A USDA waiver is allowing Smith County Schools to feed students free lunch and free breakfast this school year. We are encouraging qualifying families to complete a Free and Reduced Application at the beginning of the school year, unless you received a Notice of Direct Certification, so that your information is already on file in case the waiver expires prior to the end of the school year. You can apply by filling out the paper copy or online at www.lunchapplication.com*.

Students having a Free or Reduced status also helps in the funding of multiple programs in our school system. Some of these include Parent Engagement Activities/Nights, Literacy and Math programs and school internet service. These funds also provide students with Chrome Books, workbooks and miscellaneous supplies.

There will be NO refunds issued for student's current balances. These funds can be used to cover ala carte' (extra items) purchased and will carry over to the next school year. Any charges prior to this waiver are still due. This includes any charges from previous years.
