- · Fever or chills

- · Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- · Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

If your student is exhibiting one or more of these symtpoms, COVID protocol may need to be followed.

Please Note the Following Items:

- 1. The use of at home tests is not permitted at this time.
- 2. Other known and documented diagnoses (Allergies, Asthma, etc.) will be considered when determining if a student needs to be sent home. If symptoms are profound enough for a student to miss school, COVID protocol will be followed. Known diagnoses must be signed by a doctor and submitted to the Nurse's office to add to the student health file.
