- District plan based on guidance from State of Illinois, CDC, IDPH, MCDPH, liability insurance provider, and legal advice
- Guidance is based to maintain in-person learning



- Fluidity of guidance and conflicting local assessments
- Expect health guidance to change and D50 recommendations to constantly evolve this year as we react to changes
- Policy 4:182 -- quick response capacity
- Governor's mask mandate issued August 4, 2021
