Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to the 2022-2023 PSRC School Year! The Public Schools of Robeson County Testing and Accountability Department is responsible for the training, materials distribution, scanning, and reporting of all North Carolina Department of Public Instruction and federally required assessments. These assessments include:

- North Carolina End-of-Grade (EOG) English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics assessments in grades 3-8 (May 26-June 9, 2023).
- North Carolina End-of-Grade (EOG) Science assessment in grades 5 and 8. (May 26-June 9, 2023).
- NCDPI Career-Technical Education Tests (Select CTE Courses) (First Semester: January 19-25, 2023) (Second Semester: June 5-June 9, 2023).
- North Carolina End-of-Course (EOC High School) assessments in English II, NC Math I, NC Math III, and Biology (First Semester: January 19-25, 2023) (Second Semester: June 5-June 9, 2023).
- PSRC Early College EOC Assessments (December 12-16, 2022) (May 18-24, 2023).
- Amplify (mClass K-3 Literacy Assessment) (September 7-September 27, 2022) (January 20-February 13, 2023) (May 10-May 31, 2023).
- **Grade 3 BOG** (September 7, 2021).
- RTA (Read to Achieve) Grade 3 (June 6, 2023).
- RTA (Read to Achieve) Grade 4 Transition Student Test (October 11, 2022).
- ACT for Grade 11 (March 7, 2023).
- **PreACT** for Grade 10 (November 7-11, 2022).
- ACT Workkeys for Grade 12 (November 28-December 2, 2022) (February 27-March 3, 2023).
- CCRAA (Career College Readiness Alternate Assessment) Select Grade 11 students (March 7, 2023).

- *AP (Advanced Placement) High School Assessments (May 1-12, 2023).
- The ACCESS for ELL's assessment is administered to all students in grades K-12 identified as English Learners (EL) (January 23-March 10, 2023).
- Based on their educational needs, alternate assessments are also available for students with disabilities as identified through the Exceptional Children's (EC) program.
- *NC Check-Ins (Local Decision Assessment) are formative assessments developed in conjunction with the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction. The NC Check-Ins are administered three times per school year in Grades 3-8 in Math and Grades 4-8 in English Language Arts (ELA) Grades 5 and 8 Science, NC Math I, NC Math 3, English II, and Biology.
 - High School Check-Ins: (Math 1, Math 3, English II, Biology)
 - October 10-14, 2022, December 12-16, 2022, March 13-17, 2023, and May 1-5, 2023.
 - Early College: September 19-23, 2022, November 1-14, 2022, and February 13-17, 2023.
 - NC Check-Ins Grades 3-8: (3-8 Reading, 3-8 Math, 5 & 8 Science)
 - October 24-28, 2022, January 30-February 3, 2023, and April 24-28, 2023.

The Public Schools of Robeson County Testing and Accountability Department reports and collects state and federal data. This data allows Principals to evaluate and make critical decisions regarding instruction and adjusting to the specific needs of the school.
