Teachers will exchange your student's school supplies for an enrollment packet. PLEASE send the enrollment packet back with your student on THURSDAY, AUGUST 12, COMPLETELY FILLED OUT.

EVERY student in school qualifies for FREE BREAKFAST & LUNCH for the 2021-2022 year. You STILL need to fill out the lunch form and return it so we can get full credit for each student. THIS IS VERY BENEFICIAL TO OUR SCHOOL FUNDING!! PLEASE RETURN THE COMPLETED FORM.

From now until further notice, only Lookeba-Sickles School students and employees will be allowed inside our buildings. Anybody else, MUST make prior arrangements through the school offices, and must pass the temperature / health requirements to be allowed into our buildings.

MASKS ARE HIGHLY RECCOMENDED BUT ARE NOT REQUIRED. This is a directive from our State Legislature, and will remain that way until further notice.
