According to the Texas state definition:

§29.121. Definition

In this subchapter, "gifted and talented student" means a child or youth who performs at or shows the potential for performing at a remarkably high level of accomplishment when compared to others of the same age, experience, or environment and who:

- (1) exhibits high performance capability in an intellectual area;
- (2) excels in a specific academic field.

The purpose of this form is for teachers of grades kinder through fourth to refer students who may be gifted in general intellectual ability, specific subject matter aptitude, and/or creative and productive thinking ability. Teachers of grades 5-12 will be identifying students who may be gifted in language arts, social studies, science, and math. As a professional educator, you are in a unique position to refer students with particular characteristics.
