**STUDENT HEALTH** - Immunization requirements for the 2023-24 school year.

**Polio**- 3-4 doses for Pre-K entry and all students, with at least 1 dose on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

**DTaP**- 4-5 doses for Pre-K entry and all students, with at least 1 dose on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

**MMR**- 2 doses for Pre-K entry and all students, with at least 1 dose on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

**HIB**- 4 doses by age 15 months or 1 dose at 15 months

**Hep B**- 3 doses for Pre-K entry and all other students

**Hep A**- 2 doses for Pre-K entry and all other students

**Varicella**- 2 doses for Pre-K entry and all other students

**PCV**- 3-4 doses, with 1 dose after age 1, or 1 dose after age 2

**Tdap**- 1 dose at age 11-12, or for 7<sup>th</sup> grade entry

**MCV**- 1 dose at age 11-12, or for 7<sup>th</sup> grade entry

**TRANSPORTATION** - Information on transportation (which bus to ride, pick-up time and location) may be obtained from your child's school.

**MEALS** - Information on lunch and breakfast menus may be obtained from the cafeteria or school website.

**AGE REQUIREMENTS** - To attend Dilley Independent School District, Kindergarten children must be five years old on or before September 1, 2023. To attend the first grade, children must be six years of age on or before September 1, 2023.

**SPECIAL EDUCATION** - For information on programs for the handicapped or special education students, call the campus principal.
