Registration: Registration will begin in the gym, Wednesday, August 11th from 8:30am-12:00pm. At this time you are asked to have August tuition payment, volunteer deposit, books/fees, and the technology payment.

Myself and Kelly Threlkld (Bookkeeper) will be set up in the gym, under the basketball goal, at the far end of the gym. As you enter the gym you will notice our church is set up for the summer, while our church building undergoes renovations! Also, in the gym, there will be PreK3 and PreK4 teachers, and new and used uniform sales. This year we have new PreK and Kindergarten Panther Cub t-shirts and a panther water bottle for sale!
