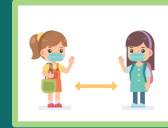

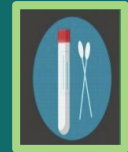

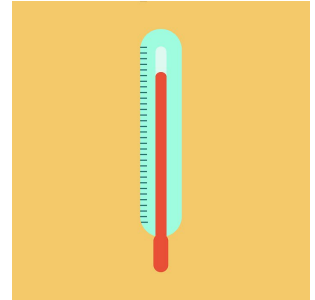


COVID Screening Begins at Home

Prior to school: Take your child's temperature. If they have a temperature of 100.4 or higher, keep them home and do not send them back to school until cleared by the school nurse.

Do NOT send your child to school if:

- ☐ Your child is feeling sick
- ☐ Your child has recently had close contact with a person with COVID-19
- ☐ If your child has tested positive for COVID-19
- ☐ If your child is showing COVID-19 symptoms



Visitors on school campus

All nonessential visitors will be limited at all campuses.

Limited numbers of visitors may be allowed in the office at one time.

ALL VISITORS requiring access to enter campus will follow an active screening.

- ❑ Parents and outside visitors are required to wear masks when entering
- ❑ Temperature screening
Temp > 100.4F = NO ENTRY



Campus

Masks are required for all students and staff indoors; masks are optional outdoors

Specific campus entry points for all students and staff:

- ❑ Each entry point will have a temperature check
- ❑ If a student shows symptoms, the student will be placed in the Wellness Room for parent pickup

Ventilation

- ❑ Open doors and windows to increase fresh air into the room if conditions like temperature, air quality, and safety permit



Hand Hygiene



Hand Hygiene

- ❑ Encourage good Hand Hygiene- wash hands for 20 seconds with soap and water or hand sanitizer
- ❑ Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
- ❑ Ensure adequate supplies to support healthy hygiene behaviors

Cover Coughs and Sneezes

- ❑ Always cover your mouth and nose with tissue when you cough or sneeze or use the inside of your elbow
- ❑ Immediately wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not readily available, clean hands with hand sanitizer

Food Service

- ❑ Maximize physical distance as much as possible while eating (especially indoors)
- ❑ Clean frequently touched surfaces. Surfaces that come in contact with food should be washed, rinsed, and sanitized before and after meals
- ❑ Given very low risk of transmission from surfaces and shared objects, food service is not limited to single use items and packaged meals



Procedures when someone gets sick

- ❑ Relocate student and/or staff member to the Wellness Room
- ❑ Each site will have staff to monitor the Wellness Center; PPE and social distancing will be followed
- ❑ Contact tracing will be conducted for confirmed positive COVID cases; impacted staff and families will be notified
- ❑ Clean, disinfect and sanitize infected areas
