WHAL IS SAP!

A SAP team is made up of school and agency staff who are available to help you access school and community services for your child. In Pennsylvania every school district is required to have a plan for identifying and assisting students who experience barriers to learning.

The SAP team will help you find services and assistance within the school and if needed, in the community

How Does My Child Become Involved in the Program?

Your school's SAP team will help you find services and assistance within the school and if needed, in the community. We do not diagnose, treat or refer your child for treatment. Rather we will provide you with information; you make the choices. Remember you are part of our team. Our goal is to help your child to succeed in school.

Students come to the SAP team in different ways. Anyone can refer a student to the Student Assistance Program. Some students are referred by teachers and other school personnel.


