

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES - RICHMOND REGULAR ROUTES

Transportation is provided for the pupils of schools by authority of Title 20-A, M.R.S.A., § 5401, which stipulates that transportation is available for only those pupils who are residing within the Town of Richmond.

Reasonable maximum walking distances shall be established on the basis of distance from home to school, distance from home to a regularly traveled bus route, grade in school, a accessibility to safe walking conditions. Maximum walking distance for seventh – twelfth grade students shall be 1.25 miles. Distance shall be measured and established by the Transportation Supervisor whose measure shall be deemed accurate and true.

According to the above described criteria, transportation privileges may be allowed in the following area:

1. Elementary students (pre-k – first grade) are entitled to transportation between home, bus stop or childcare facility designated in writing by parent/guardian and school within the town limits.
2. Elementary students (second and third grade) are entitled to transportation between home, bus stop or childcare facility designated in writing by parent/guardian and school if they live on the following streets:

3. Elementary students (fourth and fifth grade) are entitled to transportation between home, bus stop or childcare facility designated in writing by parent/guardian and school if they live on the following streets:

Westwood Acres	North	Lincoln
Tulip	Clay Hill	Arch
Front (N of Lincoln)	Bridge	Front (S of Hagar)
River Road	Hill	All out of village roads

4. Middle and High School students (sixth – twelfth grade) are entitled to transportation between home or bus stop and school if they live on the following streets:

Clay Hill	Westwood Acres	Old Ferry
Front (N of Tulip)	All out of village roads

Any requests for exceptions to the above policy should be made in writing to the Transportation Director. Decisions of the Transportation Director may be appealed in writing first to the Superintendent and then the Board of Directors.
