Analytical Management, Inc. of Louisville, Kentucky, did the three-year re-inspection of the management plan for the Harrison County Schools. The management plan and re-inspection have been made available to the Kentucky Division of Air Quality. A copy is also available at each school in the office of the principal.

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requires education agencies to use accredited inspectors to re-inspect asbestos-containing building materials, which were identified in previous inspections. Re-inspection is required every three years after a management plan goes into effect. The results of the re-inspection are submitted to state agencies.

All procedures listed in the management plan and re-inspection is pursuant to and adhering to the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act as they pertain to schools.
