

Video and Audio Recordings on School Buses

The board authorizes the use of audio/video cameras on district operated school buses for the purpose of reducing discipline problems, thus providing a safer environment for the transportation of students. The reason for recording the transportation environment is to provide school officials, drivers and parents/guardians/custodians with documentation when dealing with inappropriate student behavior. Disciplinary action will be in accordance with policy and procedures 3200 and 3241, and the Student Handbook.

The superintendent or his/her designee will prepare procedures for use of the video equipment on buses, and the authorized review process for video recordings.
