



A DAY IN THE LIFE OF AN EAGLE

Wear mask/face shield upon arrival

7:40 AM - Doors open

Whether students ride a bus, walk, or get dropped off, we ask all students to arrive with a mask properly worn. *Bus riders will need to have a mask/ face shield on before boarding the bus. The mask/ face shield will remain on until the student arrives at school.*

Doors will open at 7:40 am. Preschool and Kindergarten students will be dropped off at their doors. 1st-middle school students will be dropped off in front of the building.

Students will be able to remove the mask/face shields once they are in their class. They will only be asked to wear them during a passing time when social distancing can not be possible or when working on a project that requires students/teachers to be in close proximity.

Breakfast

Free Breakfast in the Classroom

All students will eat breakfast in the classroom in their assigned seats. Students will have individual see-through sneeze guards they will use around their individual areas.

It is the expectation all students wash hands or use hand sanitizer before and after eating. In addition, desks and tables will be disinfected after breakfast.

Equity with Instruction

Learning Time

Students will learn to log into their district accounts within the first two weeks of school. Based on age, adult support may be needed. Parents will also be informed of their student's login credentials. Students will use print material and individual devices for digital access to complete learning activities.

Each student will be assigned and responsible for a Chromebook with a case. These devices will be sent home with the students and returned daily. Students will pay a \$20 damage insurance fee per student. Please contact the office if you have a question about this fee.

Mask/Face Shield wearing during school day

Transitioning classes, group projects, close proximity

When students are required to transition from one class to another they will be required to wear a mask/face shield in the hallway. In addition, if the teacher has a group project that requires close proximity and the individual sneeze guards can not be used, masks/face shields will be required. Otherwise, students will be socially distanced in the classroom as best as possible with **assigned seats.**



Lunch/Recess/Unstructured Time

Lunch in the cafeteria

Students will eat lunch in the cafeteria.

We will have 3 lunch periods and each table will have individual see-through space dividers so that students can still see and visit with friends during lunch.

It is the expectation all students wash hands or use hand sanitizer before and after eating. In addition, desks and tables should be disinfected before and after lunch.

Students will stay with their classmates during recess, given a specific area to play. Various portions of the playground will rotate daily based on a building schedule.



Wear mask upon dismissal

Adjusted dismissal procedures

Students will be expected to wear a mask/face shield upon exiting their last classroom for the day. Masks/face shields should remain on until students are in their personal vehicle, have exited the school bus and socially distanced from other riders, or are off school property.

Schools will reduce end of day hallway congestion by staggering dismissal times or adjust dismissal procedures to keep students from co-mingling unnecessarily.



Health Services

What if my child gets sick at school?

Students will be sent to the Nurse's Office where she will conduct a screening. If the student has multiple symptoms of COVID-19 then she will place the student in an isolation booth and contact parents. Parents will need to pick the students up within 30 minutes so please make sure you have multiple people that can be called if parents are unable to take off work.

Freeman Telehealth

Westview has partnered with Freeman and will be offering a Telehealth Clinic to our students and staff. Students or staff will be able to see a doctor during school hours without ever having to leave the school for minor health visits. Freeman hospital will bill all insurance or Medicaid.



Cleaning

Routine Cleaning

FDA approved cleaners and sanitizers will be used throughout the day. A Static Fogger with disinfectant will be used in classrooms at least one time during the day when students are not present (electives, lunch, etc).

Evening cleaning will include a UV-C Air & Surface Disinfection Lamp that are being used in Hospitals and EMS vehicles as an extra layer of protection. This lamp kills 99.99% of germs that cause CoVID-19, C.Diff, MRSA, and various bacteria and viruses.

This framework was derived after analyzing the logistics of school operations, stakeholder feedback and reviewing the following guidance documents: American Academy of Pediatrics, Harvard Healthy Buildings, and the Centers for Disease Control.
