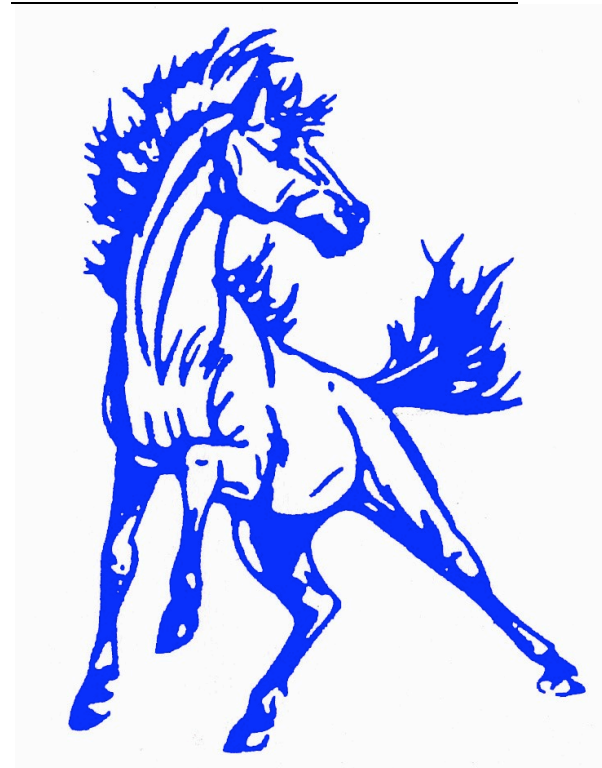

Wabaunsee High School is located 30 miles east of Manhattan, Kansas and 30 miles west of Topeka, Kansas. Situated in the scenic Flint Hills, Wabaunsee High School offers the communities of Alma, McFarland, Paxico, and Maple Hill an education program based on small class size, proven educational practices, and an experienced staff. The following exemplify Wabaunsee High School's commitment to excellence.

1. Advanced Placement and advanced course work in mathematics, language arts, science, and foreign language.

2. Dual Credit College and vocational training programs through the Kansas EduKan program, Highland Community College, Manhattan Area Vocational School and the Kaw Valley Technical School.

3. A computer and technology ratio of less than 2 to 1.

4. Environmental studies emphasis through an outdoor natural grassland classroom where students incorporate local technology along with NASA and Kansas State University for environmental studies. The program also continues in

stream quality management and in Agriculture Science and Horticulture.
