CHANGES TO COVID-19 PROCEDURES FOR THE 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR

- Masks are required for all individuals over two years of age when indoors, including all students, staff, and visitors regardless of vaccination status. The White Hall School Board will reevaluate the mask policy at the October 12th board meeting.
- Masks are **strongly** recommended at outdoor events.
- Breakfast will be served daily, beginning at **7:45 a.m.**
- Individuals exposed to a confirmed case of COVID-19 will **not** need to be quarantined if they have **no symptoms** and **both the infected and exposed individual were consistently and correctly wearing a mask.**
- Individuals who are **fully** vaccinated (at least 2 weeks have passed since their final dose) may not have to quarantine if **they do not develop symptoms of COVID-19.**
 - Symptoms may include: Fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting
- If a student or staff member experiences symptoms or have been in close contact for more than 15 minutes with a positive case, they are encouraged to contact Kelly Andrews, WHSD Nurse, at 870.835.3869 for an appointment to get at FREE COVID-19 Rapid Screening test.
- The White Hall School District will continue to follow the ADH and CDC guidelines to provide a safe environment daily. We are taking precautionary measures to be proactive in preventing the potential spread of COVID-19.
