The Highland CUSD No. 5 Board of Education conducted a special board meeting last night to consider and discuss ongoing mitigations to start the school year. As you are aware, Governor Pritzker issued another Executive Order on August 4, 2021. The Board meeting allowed public comment from 24 individuals who signed up to address the board with a crowd of about 75 in attendance and approximately 380 viewing on live stream. The Board voted 5-2 to amend the current Return to School plan to include the requirement of masks by all individuals entering our K-12 schools when children are present per the executive order.

This was a very controversial topic and one that the Board considered a variety of information.
