End of Course Exams/Assessments Information Spring 2023

- Notre Dame High School is a college prep high school with the mission to educate young women to become Confident, Compassionate Christian leaders. Synthesizing content material at the end of the course exams/assessments is an essential part of fulfilling the mission of NDHS and preparing our students for college.
- End of the Course Exams/Assessments will take place May 22-25 (Monday-Thursday) in Theology, English, Math, Science, Social Studies, World Language for Freshmen, Sophomores, and Juniors. Seniors take their exams May 11 and 12.
- Students are only required to be on campus during the time of their exams.
- Final exams are a 60-minuted timed assessment.
- With the help of your advisor, please complete the schedule on the previous side of this sheet to determine the times you are expected to be on campus each day during exam week.
- Notre Dame High School will be open from 7am-5pm, May 22-24 (Monday through Wednesday). Thursday, May 25, Notre Dame High School will be open from 7am-1pm.
- There will not be AM homeroom; attendance will be taken at the beginning of each exam session.
- The school's café and the school's library will be open during the school day for students not in an exam session. Students should be either in an exam session, in the library, or in the café during their time on campus May 22-25.
- Students entering after 8am should enter via the main doors at the front of campus and go directly to the library or café.
- The café will have food available for purchase from 8am-noon. All food should be consumed in the café.
- Students may follow the dress down guidelines found in the school's handbook during this week.
- Students that work with Mrs. Hess: please meet with Mrs. Hess to discuss arrangements for your exams.
- Student drivers may park in any spot on the front parking lot or use the overflow lot.
- Power School viewing will be turned off at 8am, Monday, May 22 through 9am, Friday, May 26.
