ROBUST SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Robust safety protocols are in place at school campuses and RCS facilities, including needed personal protective equipment, frequent disinfecting, and hand washing. RCS will continue the use of waterfilling stations.

ADDITIONAL SUPPORT

Increased staffing to effectively clean and disinfect schools.

HYGIENE

Restrooms and handwashing sinks in classrooms are stocked with soap and paper towels. Hand sanitizer stations are available in locations throughout all school campuses.

RETURN TO SCHOOL PHASES

PHASE ONE

- RCS highly recommends that faculty, staff, and students wear a mask indoors, however it is not required. Drivers and passengers will be required to wear a mask on all RCS school buses.
- Students will eat meals in the cafeteria.
- Visitors will be allowed on a limited basis.

PHASE TWO

If 1% of the **total school population** reports positive COVID-19 cases within a 7 day period, the school will transition to phase two for a minimum of two weeks.

- All faculty, staff, and students will be required to wear masks indoors, and on RCS school buses.
- Students will eat ALL meals in the classroom.
- All visitors will be restricted from the school's campus.

PHASE THREE

Any additional restrictions or changes per school or district will be made as needed based on COVID-19 data.

RCS will continually review updates and provided guidance. Current COVID-19 data will be available on the Rome City Schools website starting Aug 6, 2021.
