The food drive will replace the CHS Harvest for Hunger drive that usually takes

place in March. As part of the Harvest for Hunger program, CHS will assign a value per pound for the items collected and then issue a check to the food pantry.

The varsity topped the Wolves, 73-44. Leading the team in scoring was Eliza Oltmanns and Alyssa Moschell with 13 points each. Taziah Hawkins put up 12 points.

Karlie Goergen dished out five assists in the game.

Kylie Haiar grabbed 10 rebounds to lead the team. Al. Moschell pulled down eight boards while Oltmanns had six rebounds.

The team shot 24-of-69 (35%) from the field; and sank

17-of-26 (65%) from the free throw line.

With the win, the team's record moved to 2-1.

Beavers Defeat Menno

The Hanson boys' basketball team hosted the Menno Wolves on Saturday, December 17.

The Beavers jumped out to a 14-9 lead in the first quarter. In the second quarter, Hanson put up 12 points to Menno's seven points. Halftime score was Hanson 26, Menno 16. In the second half, the Beavers extended their lead by outscoring Menno, 31-18, defeating the Wolves, 57-34. Leading the team in scoring was Jayce Slaba with 19 points followed by Jackson Jarding with 13. Ethan Cheeseman cashed in nine points while Hadley Wallace had seven. Sutton Dewald put up six points.

Slaba dished out four assists in the game.

Jarding led the team in rebounding with 10 rebounds followed by Dewald with five. Wallace grabbed four rebounds.

Slaba marked eight steals in

the game while Cheeseman had four. Dewald had three steals.

Cheeseman had one block.

The team shot 21-of-39 (54%) from the field; hit four-of-17 (24%) from three point range; and sank three-of-three (100%) from the free throw line.

The Beavers move their record to 1-1.

The junior varsity downed the Wolves, 41-17. Top scorers for the team were AJ Wilber with 18 points followed by Ben Wilber with 10 points. Keaton Weber put up five points while Jeren Zens had four points. Tye Hernandez and Carter Endorf added two points apiece.

With the win, the JV moved their record to 2-0.

The Hanson Beavers play Kimball/White Lake on today, December 19, at the Mitchell Corn Palace.

Tuttle Places Second At Madison Invitational

Three Hanson wrestlers competed at the Madison Invitational in Madison on Saturday, December 17.

Hanson junior, Brock Tuttle, placed second overall in the 220 pound division. Tuttle's first round match was a bye. In his second match, Tuttle won by fall (1:16) over Seth Arntzen of Madison. Tuttle won by fall (5:38) over Cody Opitz of West Central in his third match. In the championship match, Tuttle lost by major decision (11-1) to Aiden Schroeder of Harrisburg.

Sophomore, Stetson Riggs, finished in fourth place in the 182 pound division. Riggs won by major decision (12-2) over Cyrus Maras of West Central in his first

match. In his next match, Riggs won by fall (1:54) over Triston Butler of Lennox. In his third match, Riggs lost by fall (3:22) to Gavin Van Emmerik of Tea Area. In the loser's bracket, Riggs faced Cain Grocott of West Central. Riggs won by decision (7-1) over Grocott, advancing Riggs to the third place match against Karter Headrik of Fladreau. Headrik pinned Riggs at the 1:15 mark.

Freshman, Jamin Peterson, wrestled in the 285 pound division. Peterson fell (0:44) to Doe-lue Gueibondy of Harrisburg. Peterson had a bye his second match. In his third match, Peterson lost by fall (2:43) to Charlie Becker of Dell Rapids.
