Keep your Child Learning throughout the summer!

Our students have worked hard and learned so much this year. Help keep them sharp over the summer and ready for the next school year. Here are five ways to get started:

1. Read to your children, encourage them to read, talk about what is read, visit the library.
2. Look for free learning resources that are entertaining, educational and close to home—libraries, museums, parks, nature centers, etc.
3. Play fun math and word games that turn everyday household activities into learning time. For example, have your kids add up prices at the grocery store. When out driving, ask them to count things, look for certain shapes, colors, letters or words on billboards and signs.
4. Purchase some inexpensive, or find free online, educational materials that are engaging, and age and grade appropriate to practice skills or learn new things.
5. Get moving and get healthy. Turn off the TV, computer and video games - set limits to reduce screen time, and keep your kids moving with fun physical activities. Get them outside to play as much as possible!
