

DUSD #27 COVID-19 UPDATE - AUGUST 16, 2022

Due to the CDC changes related to COVID-19, DUSD #27 will begin implementing the following protocols/procedures effectively immediately:

POSITIVE CASE--ISOLATION

1. If an individual test positive (regardless of vaccination status) they must isolate for at least 5 days.

- Day 1 is the first full day following the day they were tested (no symptoms)
- Day 1 is the first full day after the day symptoms started (with symptoms)

2. Individuals may return to school/work on day 6 if:

- they had no symptoms, or
- they are fever-free for 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medication) and symptoms are improving

We highly recommend individuals wear a mask through Day 10

EXPOSED INDIVIDUALS

We will no longer do contact tracing nor will we request for individuals to quarantine. We will send out parent notifications, if possible so that parents are aware of any positive cases and be able to monitor their child for any symptoms.

If an individual has been told they were exposed to a positive person, these are the steps we will recommend:

- Although we will not mandate, we highly recommend that those that have been exposed wear a mask for 10 days
- Monitor for symptoms
- Although we will not mandate, we highly recommend the individual get tested at least 5 full days after the last exposure
