First Day of School:

Meet the Teacher:

On Tuesday, August 24th, students will have an opportunity to meet their teacher and drop off their school supplies during the following times:

Second Grade: 1:15-2:00Third Grade: 2:00-2:45Fourth Grade: 12:30-1:15

Please wear a mask to attend this event. If you are unable to attend, please send your child with his/her school supplies on the first day of school.

Breakfast and Lunch

Salt Creek School District will offer breakfast and lunch daily. Lunch and breakfast is free for all of our students. Please have a conversation with your child indicating if they will need breakfast and/or lunch. Our teachers take a lunch and breakfast count to make sure we have enough meals.

Masks

All students and staff are required to wear a face mask while at school and on the bus. Please pack a few extra masks in your child's backpack in case they need a new one!

Student Hours

Daily Schedule: 7:40-2:20 Early Dismissal: 7:40-10:40

Pick up/Drop off Information

If your child is riding the bus, please make sure that he/she is at their assigned bus stop 7 minutes prior to their pick-up time. Students must wear a mask on the bus and will be assigned a seat.

Students may arrive between 7:30-7:40. Instruction begins at 7:40. Please drop off and pick up your child in our pick up line, which is heading South on Elder Road (see map below). At drop off, you may pull up to the school and your child will exit. If you are late, and the gate is closed, please drop your child off at the main door. During pick up, please remain in your car and wait for your child to be dismissed. With staff present, students will wait outside for their ride and walk to the car when you are next in line.



Knowing your child's transportation home on the first day of school is essential. Please have a conversation with your child so they know whether or not they are taking the bus or being picked up.

If your child is typically a bus rider and will be a car rider on a given day, please follow the same guidelines of calling the office at least 30 minutes prior to dismissal.

After School Care: LEAP

The Oakbrook Terrace Park District offers an after school program, LEAP, for students in kindergarten through fifth grade. The program hours are 2:30-6:00 at Salt Creek Primary. Students from Swartz may take the bus to Salt Creek to attend. The program is also available on our early dismissal days. Additional information can be found at obtpd.org or 630-627-6100.
