The Glade Creek site; the Army Corp. Nationwide permit went out on a 30-day comment period on June 11th to July 12th. At the conclusion of this period there will be internal FEMA reviews, just like where we are currently with the Cherry River Campus. Glade Creek will then go out for a 30-day comment period.

FEMA has been proactively working with the CPC and HQ on this project in order to reduce turn-around times. The OLA / Congressional Notification reviews are typically a longer process. All levels of management will be working to see this through, the congressional notifications must follow their process by law.

Superintendent Tetrick is hopeful to have everything completed by November 1, 2019, therefore we can break ground in November at both sites.
