### 6. Work Session:

a. (c). New Draft Personnel Leave policy:

Personnel Director, Ernie Jarvis brought the Berkeley County Personnel Leave Policy as an example of what he is working on for this county. He stated that he is working with Mr. John Estep and others to make sure that the policy covers all aspects. He also stated that paid leave is extended through FLMA, sick bank, and donated days that truly extend the amount of days an employee may receive.

- b. Student Academic Performance
  Nothing at this time.
- e. (a). Potential site proposals for relocation of schools affected by the flood.

Dr. Penix explained that the board had received notice from the State Office, needing potential site recommendation for the new locations of the schools.

Superintendent Burge-Tetrick explained the survey that is out for public input using the Survey Monkey Site; there were 237 comments made some were exact while others were general recommendations like (Richwood) but no exact location. Out of the 237 the most repeated were: The Dillard Farm, Craigsville Drive Inn, Glade Creek Industrial Park and Collins Harwood/Old Cherry River Bank area (combined area together).

She explained that there are a lot of different configurations that will need to go into the work of finding a place. Also, Dr. Penix explained that when the school was built for SJHS/SMS it was built to hold 850 students, now we have 500, as RHS was built for 1200 students, now there are 400. Therefore the funding that Nicholas County Schools will be for a total of students that we now have, not what the buildings were built for. Each site will have to be looked at as having utilities already on the property, and a road or access into the property. Every site will have to be evaluated and we will have to work with whatever is the cheaper way to get the most of the funds that we receive. Not to speak of the fact that it MUST be an area that is not in the flood way or the flood plain.

It costs \$17,500.00 for each site that is evaluated, and some of the sites we discovered that the land owners had not even been approached about their land. Dr. Burge-Tetrick is giving until the 14<sup>th</sup> day of October to finish the collection of information so that she can compile her information.

Mr. A.J. Rogers commented that he had driven to the Dillard Farm and there is no power out there meaning that the three phase power would need to be brought in, a new road would have to be constructed in his opinion it would take a million dollars to get it ready for the structures.

One other area that was suggested was where we are putting the modular units in Richwood; however it was explained you can't do both on the same property. The CRE site has had a lot of complications with the utilities. Dr. Burge-Tetrick praised the City of Richwood for helping with the parking area for CRE and all the help with the new bus loop.

Dr. Burge-Tetrick also added that due to trying to work with the citizens of Richwood and put the modular units where the public wanted them to be put in Richwood. Due to the lack of water pressure and the condition of the sewer systems there, the modular units will not be set as they are at SMS. Again, there is not enough water pressure in Richwood to support a sprinkler system; therefore the modular units will not be totally connected.

On a different subject, Superintendent Burge-Tetrick explained that she is trying to update the Coach's pay; she is using a system that will be fair among all coaches using a formula per student and not per sport. She feels that the sports should be done by a set formula instead of based on one sport bringing in more money than another, this still doesn't make it right. The goal is to have as many students involved in a sport as possible.

# 7. Adjournment:

Upon motion by Mr. Fred Amick, seconded by Mr. Phil Berry, the board unanimously consented to adjourn this special meeting of the Nicholas County Board of Education. The meeting adjourned at 9:50 p.m.
