The purpose of the meeting was to conduct business regarding the flood recovery, contracts, bids, the contract bus for Sugar Grove and personnel.

- 1. Call to Order along with a moment of reflection:
 The meeting was called to order by Board President, Dr. Gus Penix.
- 2. Approve the agenda:

Upon motion from Mr. Darrell White, and second by Mr. Phil Berry, the board unanimously agreed to amended the agenda and add Action item b.

Upon motion from Mr. A.J. Rogers, and second by Mr. Phil Berry the board unanimously agreed to amend the agenda and add action item c. The facilities rental agreement and lease between NCBOE and Ventures Incubator Inc. of Virginia, owner of the former Watergate Motel property.

3. Action items:

a. Consider flood relief contract bids for schools affected by the floods.

Marie McCauley and Dave Ferguson of ZMM came before the board to explain the modular bid proposals for Summersville Middle School. The lowest bid came in from Advance Modular, \$4,386,250.00 however the completion date was not until February 28, 2017. The next closest bid with the completion date of November 28, 2016, required by the board was Modular Genius at \$5,248,755.00.

Dr. Donna Burge-Tetrick explained to the board that FEMA has verbally agreed with the decision of going with the second bidder due to meeting the bid deadlines.

Upon motion from Mr. Fred Amick and second by Mr. Darrell White the board unanimously agreed to approve the superintendents' recommendation and award the contract bid to Modular Genius in the amount of \$5,248,755.00 for Summersville Middle School modular units and site preparation.

b. Bus request:

NCHS requested two pep buses to attend the James Monroe football game on September 30, 2016.

Upon motion from Mr. A.J. Rogers second by Mr. Phil Berry the board unanimously agreed to approve the bus request.

ZMM gave an updated presentation on the modular units for Richwood Middle School. The board members expressed concern with the sewage issues at Cherry River Elementary in the past few days. The bus loop, parking area and parent drop off was also discussed.

January 2nd, 2017 is the expected time line for completing both RMS and RHS portables. Additional modulars will be placed at the Beaver location.

c. Facilities Rental agreement and Lease with Ventures Incubator, Inc. of Virginia.

Board Treasurer, Kevin Hess explained that this would be the new parking and bus loop area for Cherry River Elementary and Richwood Middle School located on the former Watergate Motel property. In lieu of rent, we will pay the property taxes starting with year 2016. The City of Richwood will pay the delinquent taxes from 2015. This will be effective September 27, 2016.

Upon motion from Mr. Phil Berry and second by Mr. A.J. Rogers, the board unanimously agreed to approve the agreement and lease with the Ventures Incubator, Inc. effective 9/27/2016.
