

STUDENT SOCIAL EVENTS

All school social events are to be properly chaperoned, and must have approval of the principal. Such events as Faculty Members entertaining students or having parties for groups of students such as a cast play, football team, etc., whether at school or elsewhere are included under this regulation. Under **NO** circumstances are teachers to condone drinking, gambling, or immorality at such events.

Social events held on or off grounds must be chaperoned by at least two faculty members.

Students who come to school dance or other social functions under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or who exhibit use of either after arriving, will be asked to leave the premises. The privilege of attending such future events may be denied. In addition, the principal, following due process procedures, may suspend such students.
