STUDENT ACTIVITY FEES

Permission of the principal must be granted before teachers may collect money from pupils for any purpose. The teachers shall consult the principal, who in turn shall consult the Superintendent.

This policy shall be waived when such collections are made for hot lunch programs, school plays, or for payments for damages to school books, equipment, or building or grounds.

The Constitution of the State of West Virginia provides for a "Thorough and Efficient System of Free Schools". Consequently, there shall be no charge or fees made for materials needed to successfully complete the required curriculum.
