

RELATIONS WITH THE REGIONAL EDUCATIONAL
SERVICE AGENCY FOR REGION IV

The Board of Education of Braxton, Fayette, Greenbrier, Nicholas, Pocahontas and Webster Counties have organized into a regional Educational Service Agency for Region IV under the West Virginia Board of Education's Resolution for establishing and operating of such an agency.

The above-mentioned counties unite in establishing the Region IV Service Agency for the expressed purpose of effectively servicing and administering regional educational programs and to extend and equalize educational opportunities. Planning of such service and the coordination of the programs, projects, and future proposals is to be a major thrust in this region.

The action taken to organize this regional concept shall in no way be viewed as an effort on the part of the separate count Board of Education, named herein, to act as a forerunner for administering local school systems through a regional Board of Directors.
