P-EBT FOR K-12 STUDENTS IN ST. HELENA PARISH

Due to COVID-19, Louisiana received federal approval to issue P-EBT benefits for the 2020-21 school year. Children who receive free/reduced meals are eligible only if their school was closed, or if learning was conducted virtually (100% or hybrid).

- Eligible students who participated in HYBRID learning will receive \$48.23 per month.
- Eligible students who participated in 100% VIRTUAL (eLearning) will receive \$120.71 per month.
- Benefits are retroactive to cover the whole school year. (August 1, 2020 - May 2021)
- Only students who were identified as 100% eLearning will receive the maximum P-EBT award amount.

The chart below shows our learning status and what was submitted to DCFS for the 2020-2021 school year.

Possible reasons you did not received benefits:

- Student demographic information was not updated in the Parent Command Center.
- A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was not submitted to remain virtual.
- A letter from your doctor stating that your child should remain virtual due to medical reasons was not submitted.
- You are ineligible because classes were face-to-face.
- You were absent for face-to-face, hybrid, and eLearning classes.
- Your child was a PreK student.

If you believe you are eligible or experiencing problems accessing your benefits, please contact your child's school. Please be as specific as possible when describing your area of concern. **The deadline to resolve any issues will be Friday, September 3, 2021.**
