Most recently, San Bruno Police Association organized a week-end activity, “Fill a Cop Car” held at the Shops at Tanforan. The event, organized by Police Clerk Marianne Lindblom (pictured) and Officers Scott Rogge and Sherry Campbell, was designed to collect back packs and school supplies to assist San Bruno Park schools and students, in particular those students with economic need.

Volunteering from noon to 5 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday, September 14 and 15, Police Explorer Scouts joined a number of police officers (Canine Officer Amanda, Reserve Officer Glynnis, Dispatcher Tracy, among them) in front of the mall entrance with police cars positioned to receive the donated supplies. The community responded in mass including donations from JC Penny, Recology San Bruno, San Bruno Rotary and hundreds of residents, filling the police cars with supplies or donating cash that the officers then used to purchase more supplies.
